Mercedes Dealership: Mezzanine



Theme based flat bar posts with corporate identity pattern.

Incorporates a minimalist theme by reducing the number of glass fixing positions required.

Glass panel fixing method results in each panel spanning double the bay length.

Tubular handrail mounted offset and in-board using a matching stalk detailing.

All fabricated in stainless steel and dressed to a satin finish.

Bupa HQ: Atrium Walkway



Structural glass balustrade fixed to a Nautical themed balustrade system communal atrium walkway area.

used extensively throughout this

Designed for 1.5kN lateral loading resistance and system proof load tested under controlled inspection conditions.

Toughened glass panels secured at base using extruded aluminium channel and dry-wedge packing system.

Tubular stainless steel handrail mounted direct to glass using proprietary mounting brackets.

All fabricated in stainless steel and dressed to a satin finish

Private Residence: External Terraces



Nautical themed balustrade system used extensively throughout this contemporary private residence overlooking the Solent Estuary.

Tubular posts and top rails with multi strands of strainer wire forming the infill: All posts cranked over at top to resist climbing therefore satisfying building control inspection. All curved to match the terrace areas and the curvature of the building.

All fabricated in stainless steel, dressed to a satin finish and applied with a sealer product to resist any staining due to the location.

Office Complex: Communal Hub



Bespoke "Sail" themed balustrade with profiled posts and multi rail solid bar infill. Tubular handrail housed directly atop machine scalloped recesses.

Shaped to suit external curvature of helical hub.

All fabricated in stainless steel and dressed to a satin finish.
